

Y6 LEAVERS: GETTING STARTED

Publishing your Year 6 Leavers book is easy and can be completed in a single day. This guide will walk you through the process from start to finish.

FREE TO PUBLISH

It is completely free to create and publish your Year 6 leavers book. Parents can purchase copies of the book direct from the GoWrite store. We'll show you how you can pass on the details to parents later on in this guide.

OPTIONALLY PURCHASE A PACK

Your school can of course still purchase a class set of books. Our packs for schools include a personalised copy of the book for every pupil. Plus it comes with free, fast delivery and a free copy for the classroom.

You can purchase a set before creating your book or at a later stage. Packs are priced on the size of your class at £6 per pupil.

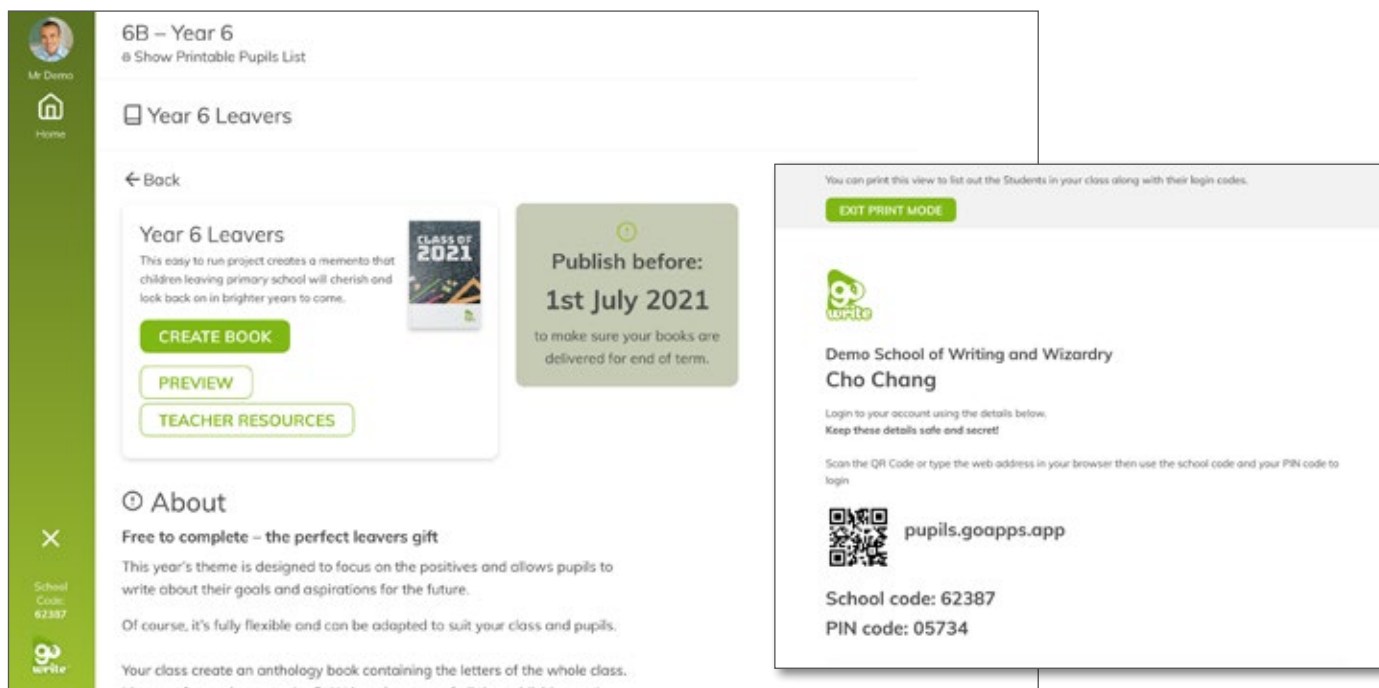


STEP ONE: COMPLETE SIGN UP

Follow the instructions in the invite email and login to Go-Write.co.uk. Launch GoWrite and select the class you wish to create the book with. Click 'Year 6 leavers book'



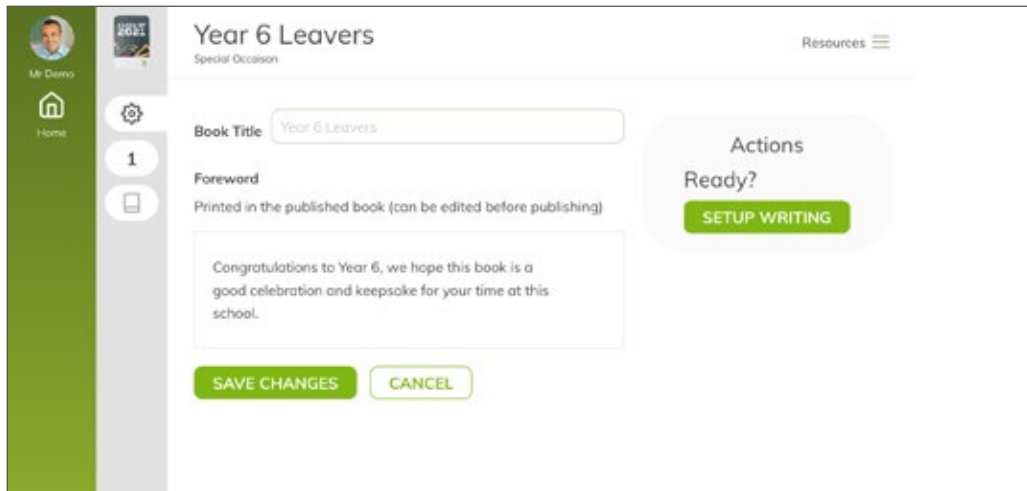
STEP TWO- GETTING STARTED



On this screen you can see the details about the book and click 'Teacher Resources' to download support materials for the book itself.

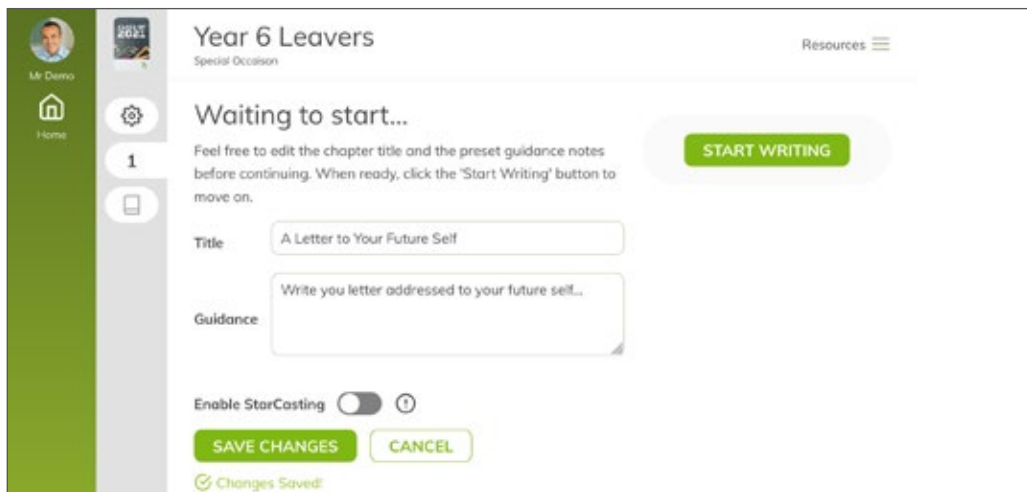
Click 'Printable Pupil List' to get a class list of logins for your pupils.

When you are ready, click 'Create book' to continue.



On this screen you can include any special messages you want to be in the foreword of every pupils' book. (You'll be able to edit the Foreword before the book is published). Press '**Save Changes**' when you're done.

When you are ready to continue, click '**setup writing**'.



On this screen you can set any guidance instructions you wish for your pupils. These will be visible for them as they write.

Click '**Save Changes**' then '**Start Writing**' to begin.

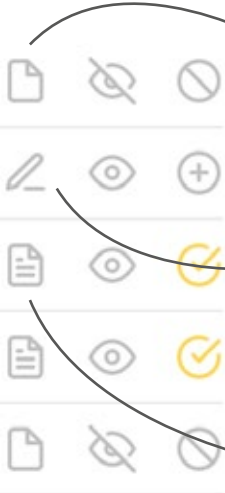

MANAGING WRITING

The blank document symbol means the work hasn't been started.

The pen symbol means writing is in progress.

The full page symbol means the work has been handed in by the pupil.

When all writing is completed, click **'End Writing'**

Eligible to win



Use this to control if the pupil's entry can win. Pupils will not be aware of this setting.

Shown in Starcasting



You can prevent an entry from being shown. Again, pupils will not be notified if their entry isn't included.

Before the Starcasting (voting) begins, you have the chance to look at the entries and can remove/edit any inappropriate examples etc. should this be required.

You can re-open the writing by clicking on **'Re-Open Writing'** Once Starcasting has begun, you can not reopen writing so make sure your class is ready!

When ready, click **'Start Starcasting'** and then **'Begin'**.

This entry will not be included in the starcasting. Pupils will not see or be able to rate it!

Pupils will be able to see and rate the entry but it **won't** be eligible to win.

Pupils will be able to see and rate the entry and it could win!

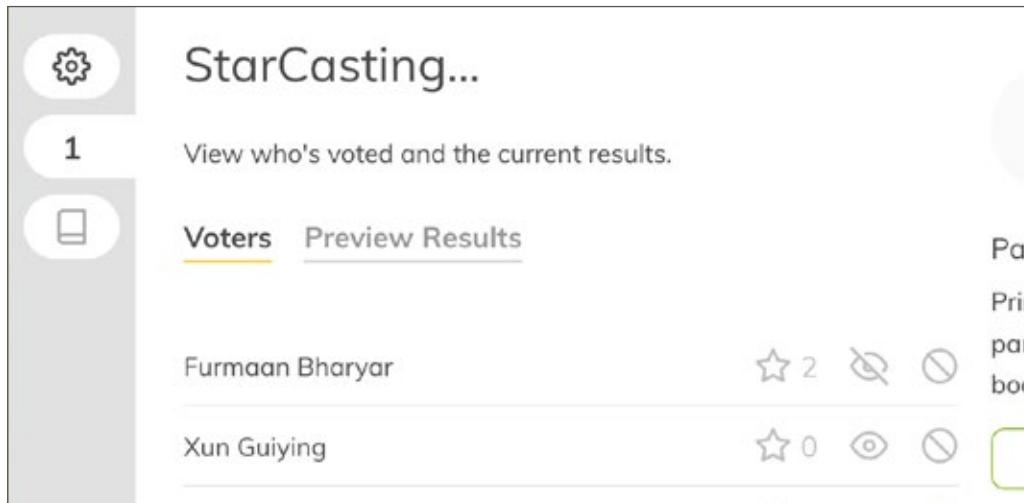
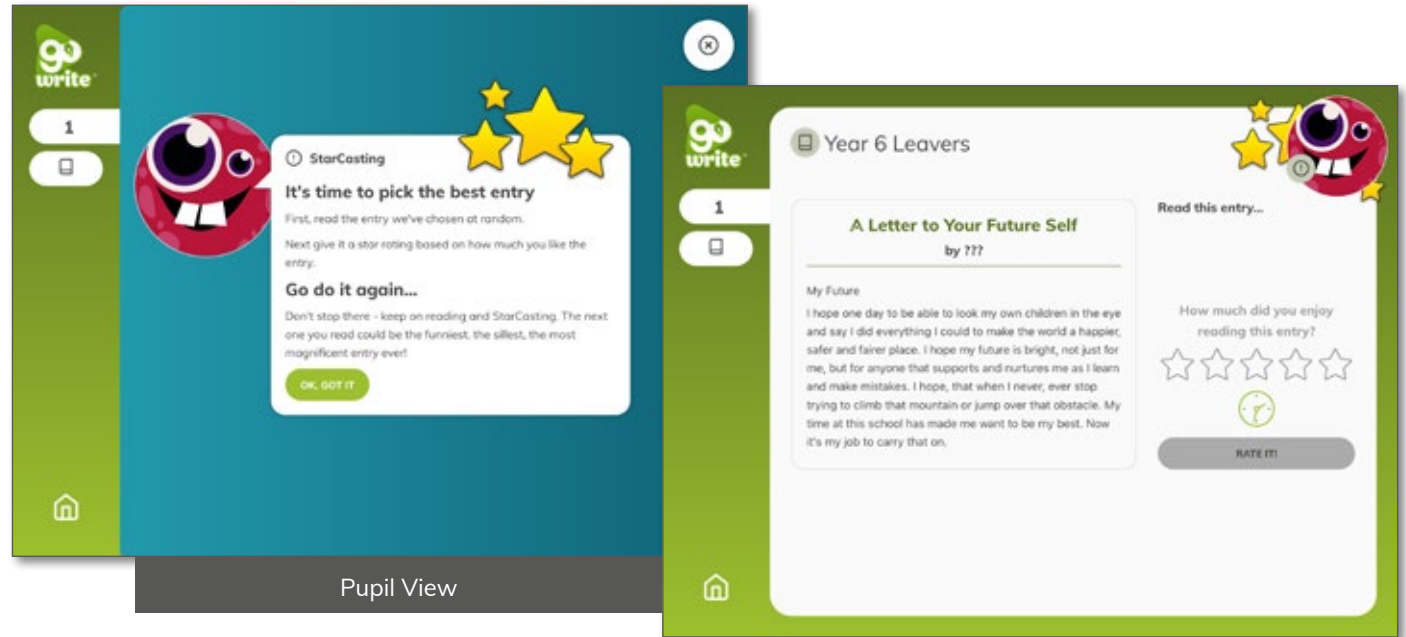
All work will be included in the finished book, regardless of the settings you choose for starcasting. You can edit any piece of work prior to publishing.

STEP 4 – STARCASTING

Starcasting is our anonymous voting system where pupils read each others' work and then give a star rating for each piece of writing.

Don't forget to spend some time with your pupils thinking carefully about the starcasting process – encourage them to take their time and read and vote thoughtfully!

Your pupils can vote and read as many pieces as there are in the class (except they never see their own work!)



You will now be able to see the voting as it happens! The stars show many times your pupils have voted.

Click **'Preview Results'** to see the current results.

When you are ready, click **'End Starcasting'**.

Pupils can each get a personalised copy that features their name on the cover. Every pupil's entry is included in the book starting with the class winner.

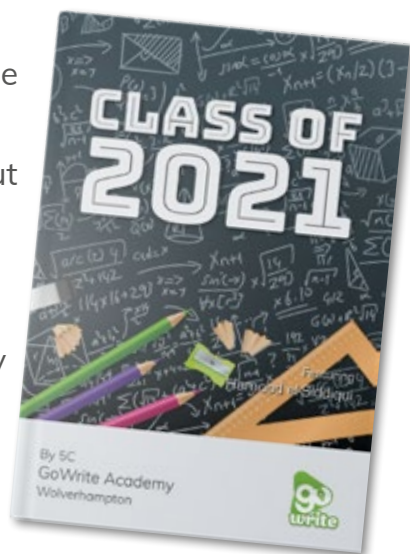
PURCHASE BOOK PACK
